Registration is still open for new groups

First Payment Instalment

For new sign-ups, individualised payment plans will be created so that you can join in the fun! You can find a full breakdown of the costs in Bulletin #1.

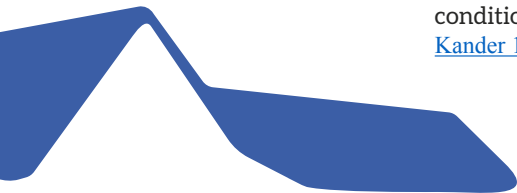
Second Payment Instalment

The due date of the second payment instalment (80% of your booking) is communicated through our staff by email. You can pay your instalment by [bank transfer](#) or via [PayPal](#) (4 % fee). To pay with PayPal, please visit our [website](#) and select PayPal from Section 2. "Pay Prepayment". Please note you will incur fees from your bank, so we use PayPal for smaller groups.

Please remember to use the account information of the currency you are paying in. (for example, if you would like to pay in Euros, use the details of the Euros account)

You can find the full cost information in Bulletin #1 in the annexe.

If the 2nd instalment is not paid before the due date, the booking will be cancelled, and the 1st instalment will be forfeited to the Centre. Check out the terms and conditions of Kander 100, including the refund policy at [Kander 100 Terms and Conditions](#).





Visa support letter

Do you need a visa to get to Kander 100? On the [website of the Swiss government](#), you can see if you need a visa to stay in Switzerland. If a visa support letter is required, the participants must request this as soon as possible to make sure that it can be issued in time. Full payment is required before a support letter can be issued. Therefore, for participants requiring a visa support letter, the 1st and 2nd instalments are both due within a month after applying for Kander 100. If the 2nd instalment is not paid before the due date, the booking will be cancelled, and the 1st instalment will be forfeited to the Centre. Be aware that you apply as soon as possible to make sure that there is enough time to issue the visa support letter.

Refunds will only be considered when the denial of a visa to attend Kander 100 occurs if an individual follows the application procedures, deadlines, or processes outlined by the appropriate governmental authority. The only instance where a refund can be made is when the Swiss government denies visa issuance. In such a case, relevant evidence should be submitted.

Requests for refunds of the Kander fee will be considered only under the following conditions:

Visa denial requests must include the following information with any request:

- Booking number of the group
- Copy of visa appointment email (with date)
- Copy of visa denial letter. The letter must show evidence of why the visa request was denied (with the date)
- Must be received via 2023@kisc.ch by 15th of May 2023
- Must only include a request for a refund of Kander 100 fee.

Once our team gathers all requests, we will evaluate each case based on the evidence given, and communicate with the groups/contingents the decision made by our management team.

Camping and Cooking - Rentals

If you are camping with us and you'd like to rent tents, tables & benches, gas, etc. you can submit a request through [the booking form](#). Rentals are done on a first-come, first-served basis and rental fees are not included in the package price. Groups who are on food supply package only can request cooking sets free of charge, with limited availability.

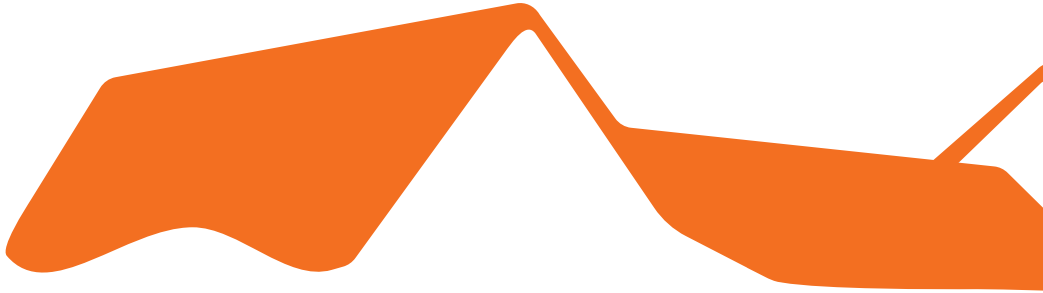

Dietary requirements



All guests (including those on the self-catering package) will receive at least 1 meal catered by the Kander100 team. Please make sure you fill out the Dietary requirements for every cub/scout/guide/adult on your booking. We can cater for the most common dietary requirements, such as Vegetarians, Vegans, Gluten, Lactose, Dairy, and Nut-free diets. Guests with other special diets can specify their requirements on [Kander 100 portal](#) starting from the end of March 2023. Group/Contingent leaders will get notified when we start accepting submissions. While we do our best to cater for the different requirements, we prepare all the meals in the same kitchen, so we cannot guarantee that the meals are 100% allergen-free.



Programme



Allocation of the off-site programmes can be found on Kander 100 Portal

The off-site programme is part of the core of the program area of Kander 100 and seeks to give the opportunity to each participant to experience the surroundings and marvel at the diverse nature of the Swiss alpine environment. One day of hiking and one day of Alpine Experience are included in the Kander 100 fees. For the groups that have already signed up for Kander 100, the allocation of these activities and on which days they are on can now be found on Kander 100 portal: booking.2023.kisc.ch. This can be accessed only by the contingent/group leader, who should have received a special login by email. This gives you the opportunity to already start planning any additional fun activities that you might like surrounding these dates!



External activities and Hut Experience (with additional fees)

From the 1st of March 2023, the bookings for the Hut Experience and other External activities will start! These activities come with additional fees but can make your time during Kander 100 even more amazing and memorable. You can book these activities through our [website](#). You will need to register, and after registering, you will find the page “Book Activities – Summer” under the menu “Book”. Please keep in mind that these activities need to be booked in advance by your group, and they work on a “first-come, first-served” basis. In addition, you cannot book any guided activity by KISC during Kander 100. You should select the “Guided Externally” and/or “Mountain Huts” options. In the first bulletin, we already mentioned these activities, and we would like to remind you about these amazing experiences that you can book.



Hut Experience

Hut Experience Have you ever thought about how it would be to live in the middle of the Alps? Well, wonder no more because now it is time to experience it! Spend one night in one of many different huts built high up in the lost mountains of the Berner Oberland, and be amazed by a night full of stars, the sounds of the wild animals, and the beauty of the green pastures. The hut experience is not included in the Kander 100 main programme package and must be booked in advance at an additional cost.
